Abstracts Submission Guidelines

Theme: "EPIDEMIOLOGY FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT IN AFRICA"

Subthemes:

- 1. Epidemiology, policy development and community health (including environmental epidemiology)
- 2. Disease surveillance and response
- 3. Epidemiology transition & Non communicable diseases
- 4. Methods in epidemiology
- 5. Delivery science and implementation research

To facilitate the submission process and the subsequent follow up process, please consider the following guidelines, tips, terms and deadline mentioned.

Guideline for the abstract structure:

- The maximum word limit for the abstract is 300 words. The total word count does NOT include the information at the top of abstract or the heading of the body. The abstract must include the following information:
 - o Title, authors and their affiliation
 - o Background information related to problem identification and objective
 - Methods
 - Main results
 - Conclusion
 - Keywords (not more than three)
- Please follow the format provided carefully
- Your abstract should be submitted in English

Steps to follow for your abstract submission

Once you have prepared your abstract according to the above guidelines,

- 1. Submit your abstract by filling it in on the afeaweb.org website
- 2. After submission you will receive an acknowledgement of the receipt of the abstract via an email
- 3. All enquiries on matters related to abstracts should be sent to abstracts@afeaweb.org

Deadline for the abstract submission

- Please submit your abstract before 15 February 2019
- Submit well before the submission deadline in order to be eligible for Early Bird rate to reserve your seat for the conference

Other important dates

• Early bird registration deadline: 1st March

Regular payment deadline for all presenters: 15th March

About the review process

- Your abstract will undergo a double blind peer review within one week of receipt by the international scientific committee
- If revision is required, the revised abstract must be sent back within a week
- If your abstract is accepted, you will be invited to register for the 5th Africa Regional Epidemiological Conference 2019 (AREC 2019).

Important information for the co-authors

- Please note a single registration permits only one person to attend the conference
- If the co-authors would like to attend the conference their registration and payment is required to be made independently
- Certificate will be issued for the co-authors upon registration/payment for the conference
